Statement of Intent

Policy Aims

To ensure effective implementation of this policy we will:

- a) Identify and fulfil our compliance obligations, including all legislation, standards and codes of practice which are relevant to our business.

- c) Manufacturing and site installation procedures should be designed to minimise the consumption of energy and materials Prevent pollution incidents.

- e) Where possible waste products and packaging should be reused or disposed of for recycling. Non bio degradable waste should not be returned directly to the environment where it will pollute, but should be passed on to appropriate companies for reprocessing or neutralization.
- f) Promote as reasonably practicable, responsible sourcing and the purchase of materials and services that through their use, sourcing or manufacture, have the least harmful effect on the environment.
- g) Emission of fumes, dust and noise from the company's tools, plant and machinery will be below the legal requirements. Where these hazards are present, equipment will be introduced to minimise their escape.
- h) Seek to influence our clients to adopt, and our designers to provide solutions that benefit the environment.
- i) Minimise the need to travel but where travel is unavoidable, use modern and the most efficient modes of transport.
- j) Any complaints made by third parties about the company's environmental impact will be reported to senior management for investigation.
- k) Continue to review its practices with the objective of making a positive and responsible contribution to environmental well-being and sustainability

Senior management will review this policy annually or in the event of a major operational or organisational change.

This policy will be communicated to all our employees and organisations working on our behalf, displayed at our offices, on our intranet, via our employee HR portal and made available to third parties.
